


Improving Lives Through Design Providing More Value, Doing More Than Good, and Delivering More Than Expected!



tion of this well-loved, waterfront home built in 1959. One of the main goals of the project was to put an emphasis on preserving many of the home's original features. Transitioning to an open concept floor plan, the living spaces were oriented to revolve around the home's central, double-sided fireplace. Ceilings were vaulted and windows enlarged to bring in more natural light and create fluidity between the interior spaces and the waterfront views.

The kitchen layout was one of the main focuses of the home's remodel as the owner loves to host and cook for guests. A large, central island equipped with the cooktop was designed to create a show-like atmosphere between in the kitchen, dining, and living room areas.

Chewning + Wilmer brought on Studio Mas to refresh their headquarters office in Richmond, VA. Holding one of the oldest electrical contracting licenses in the state, this project brief involved creating a unique space that supported their modern brand while paying homage to their rich history.

Chewning + Wilmer's company motto - "Wired for your future"- inspired the overall design concept by taking cues from a power grid. Linear elements, layered visuals, and sharp contrasts were used to create a playful rhythm, imitative of wires and conduits.

With an elevated guest experience top of mind in the renovation, the focus of the interiors team was to generate a branded path through the circulation spaces of the building utilizing bold graphics, historical artwork, contemporary furniture, accent lighting, and more. As a growing company, attracting and retaining new employees was also an important goal to Chewning + Wilmer. Studio Mas Creative worked to modernize the space and support the company's goals through an energetic design concept.

Chewning + Wilmer's headquarters building is comprised of a large office area adjacent to a warehouse and shop. This resulted in several distinct user types and spaces that required different levels of durability. Selecting products that met the functional needs of the users, met the aesthetic goals of the overall concept, while also sticking to the project budget was a welcomed challenge.

Emphasizing the expertise as electrical engineers, the design team selected a variety of lighting applications that were installed in feature areas throughout the building to delineate and highlight functions.

Bold graphic wall decals tell the story of the company's past, present, and future through historic photos, timelines, and project installation images. In multiple locations, the graphic concept travels from the floor to the wall and even the ceiling, naturally pulling a guest through the space.






